There is a death record for a James B. Yates, June 6, 1902 of dropsy. He was 77, doctor was Dr. Wood. Was Baptist, lived at 248 Earl Street, born in England.

also found death certificate for James' daughter (according to Uncle Harold, this James
 married an Ethel and had 2 kids - Mary, who died, age 10 or so, and a son Harold James).
 The Mary who died aged 8 1/2 in 1925 had a father named James Byron. She died
 March 16, 1925 of scarlet fever, in Isolation Hospital. was sick Feb 23-Mar. 16. Mother
 was named Ethel Rose Yates, lived at 10 Sixth Street, Kingston. On James' death
 certificate, address is 6 Sixth Street.

I have little or no info about Amelia except one note that suggests she may have married someone named Price. She was still single living home in 1901.

I know that Joseph Byron (son of James & Ann) abandoned his family here and went back to Canada, but I find no record of his death... In 1920 US census, his wife Annie is noted to be a widow.
